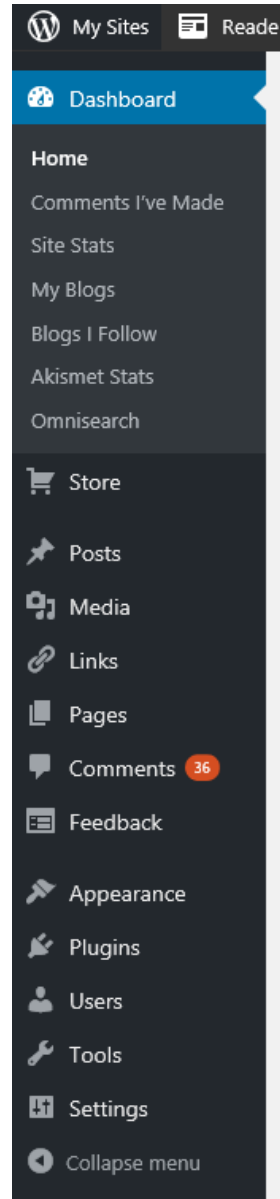


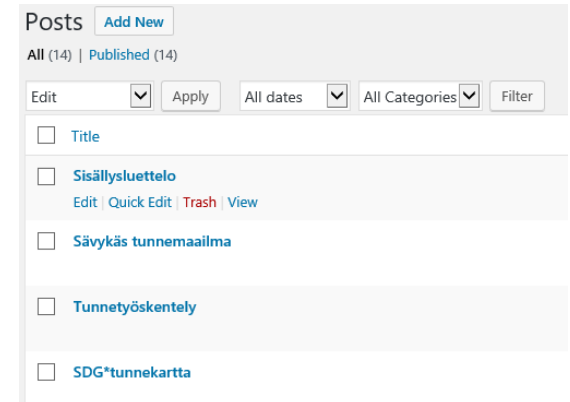
The **FIRST** control panel (dashboard)

When clicking “**W** WP –Admin” you’ll get an access for the second control level.



The **SECOND** control panel (dashboard)

When clicking “**W** My Sites”-button on the top you’ll come back to the view of the first control panel. When clicking it again you’ll be on this second control panel view again. Quite easy!



You’ll find the **THIRD** control panel (Quick Edit) from the second (WP Admin) dashboard by clicking Posts/All Posts.

When hovering the title of your post in this view, you’ll find the Quick Edit –button.

In the right hand corner there’s an option with a text “Make this post sticky”.
